## RE: CITY OF PHOENIX FIRE HYDRANT METER PERMITS

Dear Permit Holder:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that effective December 31, 2017, the City of Phoenix Water Services Department will only be issuing fire hydrant meter permits for authorized uses within the City of Phoenix water service area.

As specified in Phoenix City Code 37-11, "fire hydrants are provided for the primary purpose of extinguishing fires." Furthermore, Phoenix City Code 37-13 allows for the use of fire hydrants for construction water "where an existing service connection is not unavailable, or is of insufficient size." The Water Services Department will continue to issue fire hydrant meter permits for the following uses within the City of Phoenix water service area:

- Temporary construction water with a valid City of Phoenix project number.
- Dust control with a valid Maricopa County dust control permit.
- Temporary, short-term (less than a week) uses authorized by the Water Services Department.
